## 2008 Visitor Statistics

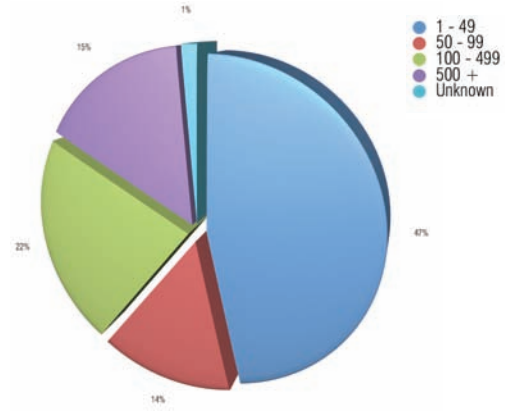

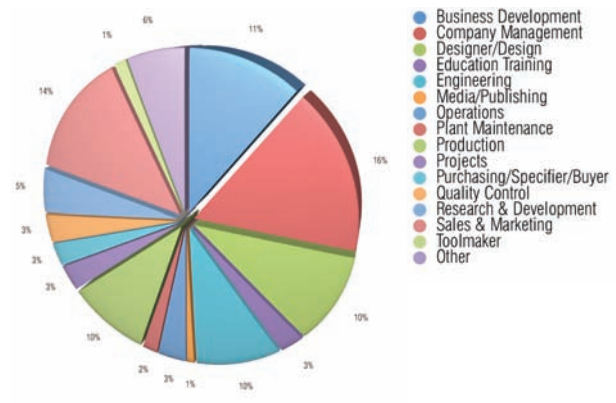

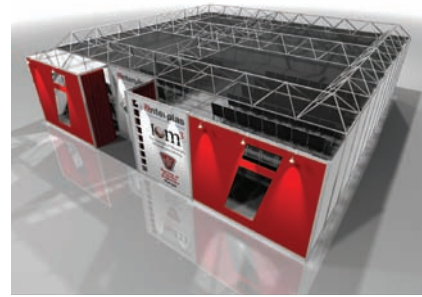
